In this document:

**Form** means the attached Request for licence back (Online, non-commercial) form, being a request from

**Non-Commercial Purposes** means:

- there can be no financial benefit to anyone in connection with the website communicating the music.
- the website must be run by a not-for-profit body that is not publicly funded.

**Music** means the musical works (including any accompanying words) that you authorised APRA to administer in your membership agreement and specified in the form.
